Please join us in sending the attached letter to Speaker John Boehner and Democratic Leader Nancy Pelosi urging them to move a responsibly paid-for multi-year surface transportation reauthorization bill in the coming months.

Very simply, we support transportation and infrastructure investment because our economy needs a national system to safely move people and deliver goods from place to place. The current extension of the Highway Trust Fund is slated to expire on May 31, 2015. This is not a long way off. We are united in our conviction that now is the time to end the cycle of short-term extensions that kick the can down the road by doing the work needed to pass a long-term surface transportation reauthorization bill.
